- We run two quiz nights per year

- ... and we managed to run both of them this year

- The 3 quizzes raised £1770 this year!

 Donations from the school community meant that we could cover our expenses and still raise £539










### FAB Cinema

- A new initiative started in June 2019
- we planned to show a film each term
- And had 3 successful screenings... including a Christmas Double Bill
- but got cut short in the Spring by Covid-19
- Raised £1075 this year













# FAB Swimming – Balfour Swimming Club



- The swimming school runs lessons throughout the school year at the Surrendean Pool on
  - Thursdays after school and
  - Saturday mornings
- Raised £3200 this year



#### Christmas Fair



- A truly special and magical event mixed with mayhem and stress!!
- Requires a lot of planning and over 100 volunteers on the day.
- Raised £4406 this year

















## Easter Egg Hunt

- Typically, an hour of 600 kids running around the school grounds looking for clues to get an Easter Egg!!!
- However, Lockdown happened and we gave the eggs away free to all the kids, and staff who were in school on the last day of school
- Made a loss of £467 this year but typically raises £1k





### **Art Exhibition**

- Every child in the school creates a piece of art for the campus Open House
- In addition we run a competition where:
  - Kids design cakes to fit the theme
  - And Fab sell hot drinks and cakes
- Typically we raise about £300 from selling cakes and nonalcoholic drinks.



### Summer Fair


 A great afternoon of fun and games as long as the weather is kind!

Raised £1.8k this year




# Happy's Circus

## 100 Club




- An initiative started in July 2019
- £5 per number, 50% of prize fund each month goes to FAB, 50% gets shared between 3 winners: 1<sup>st</sup> Prize = 25%, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize = 15%, 3<sup>rd</sup> prize = 10%
- Raised £1505 this year



# Online Ticket selling...

- Set up with the website Ticketor parents and carers were able to buy all tickets online using credit/debit cards...
- It significantly reduced the amount of admin for these events with over 99% of sales online.





#### Carry over from 2019/20:

- 1) Science Week spend: Balfour committed to a workshop of £399 which should have happened in March 2020, but will happen in March 2021 instead
- 2) BLM: The £500 for diversity books/resources has not yet been spent
- 3) Year 4 PGL trip there was £350 left over from Y4 spend after Anglo saxon workshop, and as Trustees we discussed committing it to their PGL trip if they join the current year 4s on top of their current Y5 allocation









